### **Our Mission**

In response to declining arts education in Portland Public Schools and the current state of world affairs, BroadArts, a nonprofit organization committed to celebrating women and minorities and making the world more equal, peaceful, compassionate and just, has created a unique youth arts program that focuses on using the art of performance to explore concepts of peace and freedom.

The focus of the camp will be on creating situations and experiences that enable children to explore what it means to create a world that fosters peace, love and inclusion. Through the process of creating live performance and theatre, students will

experience the joy of collaboration and creation. Over the course of one week, students will work with a total of six professional theatre artists to explore acting, music, improvisation, movement, writing and designing for the stage, while simultaneously learning and using valuable life skills needed in order to create a more peaceful and accepting world.

#### **Acting and Directing**

**Carolyne Haycraft**, a native of Australia, has an MFA in Directing from the UW-Madison, & has worked for numerous organizations, including Oregon Shakespeare Festival, Milwaukee Repertory Theatre, Bridgework Theatre & The Storybuilders. Most recently, Carolyne directed *WonderBroads* for BroadArts Theatre and was the Education Coordinator for Children's Theatre of Madison. In 2004, she was nominated for a Teaching Excellence Award granted by the UW-Colleges.

#### **Creative Writing**

**Adrienne Keith** earned her MFA in Creative Writing from Brown University. She is the author of two books for children published by Tricycle press (*Fairies from A to Z* and *Fairies: Celebrations from Season to Season*). She has taught creative writing at Brown University, Lewis & Clark College, and for Portland Public Schools. Adrienne is a recipient of the Edna L. Holmes fellowship for Young Reader's Literature from Portland Arts and Lectures.

#### **Creative Movement**

**Susan M. Kraemer** has a B.A. in Social Work & psychology with a teaching license in Special Education. She is a certified Danceability instructor for people with and without disabilities. Since 1995, she has been guiding children in creative expression through movement with in the Minnesota and Oregon School Districts. She directed *The Nutcracker*, *On the Day you were born* and *It's a Wonderful World*. Within the framework of movement, Kraemer helps children with social and emotional learning.

#### **Communication through Illustration**

**Sharon Martini** is from London, England. She is an artist, actress, singer, writer, and the author and illustrator of three children's picture books.
